Every State association shall establish and maintain a regulatory capital account in an amount and in such funds and investments that comply with the requirements of the appropriate federal regulatory authorities.
- § 54B-210(b)

The failure of a State association to maintain the required level and type of regulatory capital may be grounds for supervisory action by the Commissioner of Banks.
- § 54B-210(c)

The Commissioner of Banks may adopt rules to implement this section.
