§ 54B-39(a) Any two or more associations, when one or more is a State association and one or more is a federal association operating in North Carolina, may merge to form one association under either a State or federal charter.

§ 54B-39(b) The Commissioner of Banks shall promulgate rules and regulations to facilitate the merger of federal and State associations.
