§ 66-186(a) This Article does not affect a security interest of the supplier in the inventory of the dealer.

§ 66-186(b) Repealed by Session Laws 2004-190, s. 4, effective January 1, 2005.

§ 66-186(c) The dealer and supplier shall furnish representatives to inspect all parts and certify their acceptability when packed for shipment. Failure of the supplier to provide a representative within 60 days shall result in automatic acceptance by the supplier of all returned items.
