- § 66-317(a)

A record or signature may not be denied legal effect or enforceability solely because it is in electronic form.
- § 66-317(b)

A contract may not be denied legal effect or enforceability solely because an electronic record was used in its formation.
- § 66-317(c)

If a law requires a record to be in writing, an electronic record satisfies the law provided it complies with the provisions of this Article.
- § 66-317(d)

If a law requires a signature, an electronic signature satisfies the law provided it complies with the provisions of this Article. (2000-152, s. 1.)
