ARTICLE 2 - PROHIBITED ACTS BY DEBT COLLECTORS

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The following words and terms as used in this Article shall be construed as follows:

"Consumer" means any natural person who has incurred a debt or alleged debt for personal, family, household or agricultural purposes.

"Debt" means any obligation owed or due or alleged to be owed or due from a consumer.

"Debt collector" means any person engaging, directly or indirectly, in debt collection from a consumer except those persons subject to the provisions of Article 70, Chapter 58 of the General Statutes.

"Location information" means information about a consumer's place of abode, any telephone numbers used by the consumer, and information about the consumer's place of employment.
