- § 77-97(a)

The appointed members of the North Carolina delegation to the Commission shall receive per diem, subsistence, and travel expenses as follows:

(1) Commission members who are members of the General Assembly at the rate established in G.S. 120-3.1.

(2) Commission members who are officials or employees of the State or of local government agencies at the rate established in G.S. 138-6.

(3) All other Commission members at the rate established in G.S. 138-5.
- § 77-97(b)

The members of the Virginia delegation to the Commission shall receive compensation as provided by the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- § 77-97(c)

All expenses shall be paid from funds appropriated or otherwise available to the Commission. (2002-177, s. 1.)
