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§ 7A-456(a)
CLASS I FELONY
A false material statement made by a person under oath or affirmation in regard to the question of his indigency constitutes a Class I felony.

§ 7A-456(b)
A judicial official making the determination of indigency shall notify the person of the provisions of subsection (a) of this section.
