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The Board shall issue a license to practice as a manicurist to any individual who meets all of the following requirements:

Successful completion of at least 300 hours of a manicurist curriculum in an approved cosmetic art school.

Passage of an examination conducted by the Board.

Payment of the fees required by G.S. 88B-20.
