ARTICLE 1P - INTERSTATE MEDICAL LICENSURE COMPACT

N.C.G.S. § 90-21.189.

Dispute resolution.

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§ 90-21.189(a) The Interstate Commission shall attempt to resolve disputes upon the request of a member state, which are subject to the Compact and which may arise among member states or member boards.

§ 90-21.189(b) The Interstate Commission shall promulgate rules providing for both mediation and binding dispute resolution as appropriate. (2025-37, s. 1(a).)
