Any client who is sexually exploited by the client's psychotherapist shall have remedy by civil action for sexual exploitation if the sexual exploitation occurred:

At any time between and including the first date and last date the client was receiving psychotherapy from the psychotherapist;

Within three years after the termination of the psychotherapy; or

By means of therapeutic deception. (1998-213, s. 1.)
