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§ 90-227(a) The Board shall issue annual renewal certificates to licensed dental hygienists.

§ 90-227(b) The Board shall have the authority to establish in its rules and regulations:

- (1) The form of application for renewal certificates;
- (2) The time the application must be submitted;
- (3) The type of certificate to be issued;
- (4) How the certificate must be displayed;
- (5) The penalty for late application;
- (6) The automatic loss of license if applications are not submitted.
