ARTICLE 19 - STERILIZATION OPERATIONS

N.C.G.S. § 90-275.

Article does not affect duty of guardian to obtain order permitting guardian to consent to sterilization of a ward with a mental illness or intellectual disability.

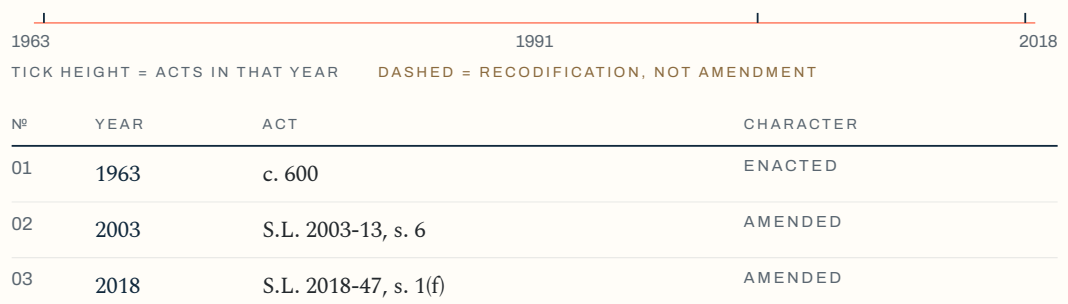
