The Board shall establish rules for the licensure of massage and bodywork therapy establishments. These rules shall include at least all of the following:

- Requirements for adequate, safe, and sanitary facilities.
- Requirements for compliance with local building code requirements, State fire safety codes, and State health inspection codes necessary to ensure the safe and effective practice of massage and bodywork therapy.
- Requirements for retention of client and ownership records.
- A description of the process used by the Board to approve massage and bodywork therapy establishment licenses.
- Requirements for initial and periodic inspections of massage and bodywork therapy establishments.
- Requirements for transfer of a massage and bodywork therapy establishment license. (2017-151, s. 3(k).)
