Each applicant shall be issued a license by the Board to engage in the practice of behavior analysis as a licensed assistant behavior analyst if the applicant meets the qualifications set forth by the Board in accordance with G.S. 90-734(a) and provides satisfactory evidence to the Board of all the following criteria:

- The applicant is at least 18 years of age.
- The applicant has passed the certifying entity's Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst examination.
- The applicant has an active status with the certifying entity as a Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst.
- The applicant has an ongoing arrangement for supervision by a licensed behavior analyst in a manner consistent with the certifying entity's requirements for supervision of Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analysts. (2021-22, s. 1(a).)
