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Any temporary help service as described in G.S. 95-47.1(16)c. that operates in North Carolina shall notify the Department of Labor in writing that the temporary help service:

- Operates only as a temporary help service;
- Establishes an employer-employee relationship with its temporaries;
- Does not operate as a private personnel service or an employer fee paid personnel consulting service.
