The following definitions apply in this Article:

Governmental entity. -

- a.The State, any county or municipality, or any department, agency, or other instrumentality thereof.
- b.Any school board, special district, authority, or other entity exercising governmental authority.

Hazardous recreational activity. - Skateboarding, inline skating, or freestyle bicycling.

Inherent risk. - Those dangers or conditions that are characteristic of, intrinsic to, or an integral part of skateboarding, inline skating, and freestyle bicycling. (2003-334, s. 1.)
